Special and/or sensitive personal data that we process

Sharing of personal data with third parties

Cookies, or similar techniques, that we use

Perz uses functional, analytical and tracking cookies. A cookie is a small text file that is stored in the browser on the first visit to this website from your computer, tablet or smartphone. Perz uses cookies with purely technical functionality. These ensure that the website works properly and that for example your preferred settings will be remembered. These cookies are also used to make the website work properly and to optimize it. In addition, we place cookies that track your surfing behavior so that we can offer customized content and advertisements. On your first visit to our website we have already informed you about these cookies and have asked permission to place them. You can opt-out of cookies through your internet browser like this to set that it no longer stores cookies. In addition, you can also delete all the information that was previously saved via the settings of your browser. View, modify or delete data

You have the right to view, correct or delete your personal data. In addition, you have the right to request your consent for the withdraw data processing or object to the processing of your personal data by Perz and you have the right to data transferability. This means that you can submit a request to us for the personal data that we hold about you in a computer file sent to you or another person named by your organization. You can request for access, correction, deletion, data transfer of your personal data or request for withdrawal of your consent or send an objection to the processing of your personal data to info@perz.nl. To make sure that the request for inspection has been made by you, we ask you for a copy of your proof of identification with the request. Make in this copy your passport photo, MRZ (machine readable zone, the strip with numbers at the bottom of the passport), passport number and citizen service number (BSN) black. This is to protect your privacy. We will respond to your request as quickly as possible but within four weeks. Perz would also like to point out that you have the possibility to file a complaint with the national data protection authority, the Dutch Data Protection Authority.
